6. SPECIAL ORDERS
 - 6.1 [Time Certain 2:10 pm] Report from President Andrew Jones (tentative)- AJ has no report, opens himself up for questions from the audience. NS asks for updates at the federal level on the EEOC matter. No update currently, we have submitted our response, awaiting reply. NS asks about executive compensation presented at the BOT meeting yesterday. AJ says he received the information at the meeting. CW asks about crosswalks, asks AJ to keep safety on mind. Any updates on H1B visas, answer no. BC asks about expanding student mental health support, students have been told that students cannot be seen, or long wait times. B. Lesen says there is still capacity, no waitlist. RS states that COTA appreciates AJ coming to events in COTA, has made a huge impact on students.
 - 6.2 [Time Certain 2:20 pm] Report from Long Beach CFA Co-President Shelly Collins- SC reports that CFA is currently in bargaining have agreed to extend the current contract until 1.31.26, today is the first session. All CFA members are welcome to attend the caucus in between the bargaining sessions. Still working with FA to protect against immigration services. BOT rally this week across various unions. SDSU has issued a no confidence vote again the Chancellor and have posted a resolution. NH asks about the Beach alerts and federal agents on campus. Beach alerts under the purview of UPD. BC asks for clarification on the question about CAPS waitlist. SC states there has never been a waitlist, students can walk in for emergency visits, which may come with wait time, or make an appointment. Currently no appointments available for first time students for remainder of semester. NS asks for time lag for appointments. SC says likely first availability is January for available appointments. CW asks if there are ongoing referral services, answer yes.

7.1 Resolution in Support of Restoring Counselor Faculty Outreach – FIRST READING--Shelly Collins, Long Beach CFA Co-President- moved by CW, seconded. SC presents the resolution to Senate. This resolution has to do with outreach that is currently sanctioned on campus. DP asks if this is unique to LB, answer yes. AK asks if this was presented to all affinity groups, answer yes. BC asks what the citation was about, SC replied was more about satellite therapy offices, not outreach. Moves to SECOND READING at next senate meeting.

7.2 [Time Certain 3:00] Report from ASI President Sonny Ciampa- SC presents on current ASI government background and activities. A plea for a faculty representative for the Judicial Branch of ASI was issued.

8.1 Proposed revision of PS 12-12: Graduation Writing Assessment Requirement (GWAR) in two parts: a policy and a committee charge (AS-1207-23/CEPC) -- SECOND READING- resuming on the UBER amendment presented by BK – moved by BK, seconded CW. Sub motion 1.8 to introduce language 2.3.3.3, PF moves, seconded. Vote on amendment, yes-35 no-12, sub motion passes. Sub motion 1.9, moved and seconded. Vote on sub motion, yes-24 no-22. Sub motion fails. Sub motion 1.13, moved and seconded. Substitute language of 2.3.5. vote on sub motion 2.3.5c yes-28 no-20, amendment fails, language is deleted. Sub motion 2.3.5b, moved and seconded. Split into 2 amendments, first “representative sample of course syllabi” vote on amendment, yes-20 no-27, language remains. 2nd amendment, delete “and student writing” friendly amendment, no vote needed. Sub amendment 2.3.5 by CB, moved and seconded, add “subject to approval by the AS” vote on amendment, yes-14 no-28, language will not be added. Sub motion 2.3.5b moved and seconded. Vote on amendment, yes-28 no-10, language is replaced. Sub motion sub motion 2.3.4 adding underlined wording, moved and seconded PFH amendment. Vote on amendment, yes-36 no-5. Vote to replace all of section 2.3, yes-35 no-4. Motion 2, vote on reordering, moved and seconded. yes-39 no-2. Stopping at this point in the policy.
