<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Minimum 2.0 overall GPA • Grades of “C” or better in GE Foundations, Arts and Humanities (Area 3), and Social and Behavioral Sciences (Area 4) • First-Time, First-Years (Freshmen) who began in Fall 2021 or later: Grade of “C” or better in Ethnic Studies (Area 6)

Students pursuing the **Single Subject Credential** must earn a grade of “C” or better in all English Education coursework. Prospective students should consult the department’s English Education Advisor early to plan their program.
