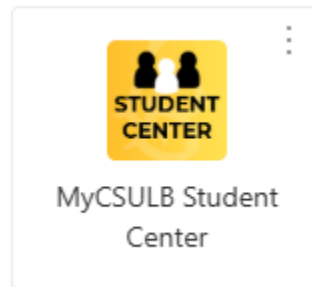
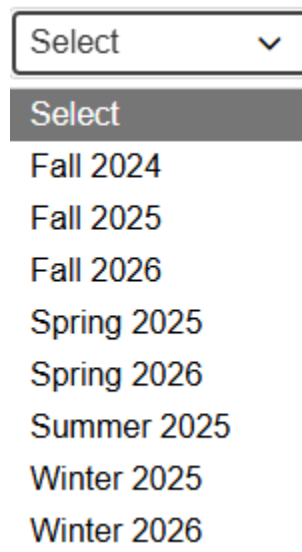


How to Check Your Request for Certification Status Guide

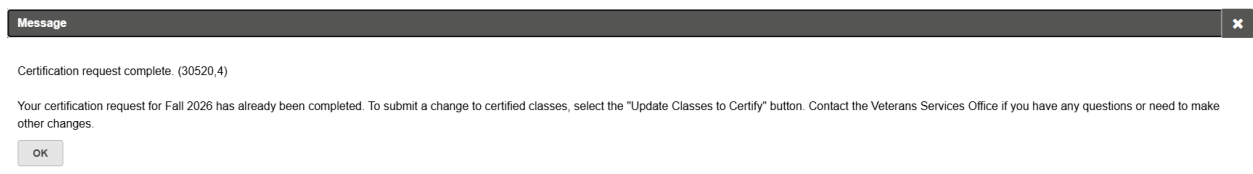
1. Log into your MyCSULB Single Sign-on account
2. Log in to your MYCSULB Student Center app.



3. Once you are logged in click on the top right corner of the “academics” box to open the drop down menu and click “Veteran’s benefits” to go to your Certification Request.
4. Select the term of which you wish to check the status of the certification for.



5. If you are certified for that term this pop up will appear:



No further actions are required.

6. If not you will be able to check the status of your request by using the following bar:

Sequence: This is the number of requests made by the student for a term. If an update is made it will populate a new sequence number.

Status: Status is the current status of your request for the term. It has several possible statuses:

Submitted: The student has submitted their request for certification.

In Review: The request for certification is currently being reviewed by the School Certifying official.

Pending: The request is pending reporting to the VA. This does not mean that the request is complete.

Reported: The request has been reported to the VA.

Withdrawn: The student has withdrawn their request for certification.

Denied: The School Certifying official has found that the request cannot be completed.
