The Academic Requirements Report (ARR) is your official degree audit.

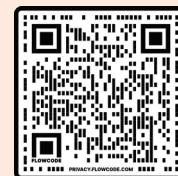
Review each term to track your degree progress.

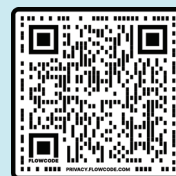
SCHEDULE OF CLASSES

POLICIES TO KNOW

UNITS NEEDED TO GRADUATE

Minimum 120 units total
40 must be upper division (#300 - 499)

- ▶ You may need Electives to reach minimum units required to graduate (an elective is any class you choose to take, #100-499)
- ▶ Review your Course History to avoid retaking a class
- ▶ Explore classes that interest you!

ADDING A MINOR

- ▶ Students can request to add a CLA minor after completing their first term at CSULB with a 2.5 in all GPAs (Overall, CSULB, and Major)
- ▶ Minors must be completed within your expected graduation term
- ▶ Contact the Department Advisor for the minor or speak with ATLAS for more information

DROPPING OR WITHDRAWING FROM A CLASS

- ▶ After the initial Drop deadline, you must request to Withdraw from a class that you no longer plan to complete
- ▶ Instructors will not drop you if you stop attending - you will earn a WU (equivalent to an F grade)
- ▶ Request to Withdraw by the official deadline via your MyCSULB Student Center

ACADEMIC STANDING

- ▶ To maintain good standing and avoid Academic Warning, keep your Overall and CSULB GPAs above a 2.0
- ▶ **Need support in a class?** Visit instructor office hours and utilize campus resources
