Virtual Supervision

Fall 2021 supervision must be virtual. No in person visit to school site.

- Schedule weekly meetings with candidates via Zoom. Must record and save to the onedrive cloud unless you are "observing" a live classroom (don't record this)!!
 - If meeting notes are not shared via S4 weekly responses, then it is necessary to have typed notes from each zoom meeting that you share with the candidate.
- Lesson delivery must be observed. This can be done via live zoom of the classroom, or prerecorded lessons by candidate that they share with supervisor. Complete the "EDSP Observation and Feedback Form with TPEs" for all lesson observations. Goal is to observe a lesson on a consistent basis (i.e. at least every other week, if not weekly)

Supporting Students

COVID procedures

Details are available on our COVID-19 information website.

- Each day you come to campus, you must complete a pre-arrival health screening questionnaire available on the university's <u>single sign-on page</u>. When entering some spaces on campus, you will be required to show that day's "green checkmark" on your mobile device indicating clearance to be on campus.
- Per County public-health guidance, you must wear a face covering while indoors
 regardless of vaccination status. Outdoors, it is recommended that those who have not yet
 received a COVID-19 vaccination also wear a face covering when six feet of physical
 distance from others cannot be maintained.
- An online training presentation will soon be available on the <u>COVID-19 information</u> website with more information about what to expect while on campus.
- If you haven't already done so, *please* receive a COVID-19 vaccination. Vaccinations are offered at many <u>sites off campus</u>, but also through Student Health Services on campus for all members of the Beach community from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Mondays and Tuesdays beginning Aug. 9. Beginning August 11, vaccines will also be offered on campus through the city of Long Beach from noon to 4 p.m. on Wednesdays and Thursdays near the entrance of the University Bookstore. The campus offers the Pfizer vaccine, while the city-sponsored clinic offers the Pfizer, Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccines.
- Using both voluntary reports of symptoms and illness by Beach community members as well as pre-arrival daily health screening information, the university will continue its contact-tracing work. In case of your potential exposure to someone testing positive for the illness, you will be notified by email if you are advised to self-monitor for symptoms, receive a COVID-19 test and avoid contact with others, or take other action.
