- We anticipate that we will run out of vaccination doses this week or next week at CSULB. At this current time, we do not know when more vaccines will arrive but we're working on it. Scott Apel, will have more updates on our campus vaccination efforts during his presentation. Also, I wanted to share with you all that I have received my COVID vaccine through the City of Long Beach.
- -We're waiting for more CARES. We anticipate around \$61 million that will go to student grants.
- -Anticipate no furloughs or layoff for this year
- -Participating on committees is important! Please consider volunteering on the Provost Search Committee.
- -Committees are working on repopulation plans; we hope 30-50 percent in person instruction but that depends on the current COVID statistics.
- -Makisha Glover-Hill question: how have you determined repopulation plans and who will be considered for in-person classes? President Conoley: I do not directly sit on this committee but I believe labs, clinical classes that are difficult to replicate online, will be prioritized for these in-person classes. More information will be available soon.
- -Jay Grosflam question in chat: Hello, on another subject. Is the new HHS building going on as planned? President Conoley: Yes, we're still planning on opening but no, we do not have funds just yet; however, we're hopeful of future funds.
- -Kerry McDaid question in chat: Are we still working towards staff being back on person by August? President Conoley: This varies tremendously; however, we're looking at policy for equitable, flexible work plan for staff members. We are working on it.
- -Nancy Torres: There is a subcommittee on employee repopulation; we'll be meeting soon to discuss repopulation plans.

- -Makisha Glover-Hill question: How are you looking at office spacing in this new environment, especially for close interactions with campus community members? President Conoley: We've purchased plexiglass and we're continuing to work on plans for physical barriers, masks, PPE...etc. Additionally, if anyone has questions after this meeting, I am always open to answering additional questions via email.
- -Luan Tinoco in chat: Can you give us an update on Athletics? Will we be able to go to a Baseball game this season? Jeff Scott: The schedule is out; however, we are not expecting fans at events, but we are selling out cutouts you see at these events, and we'll also be doing zoom events for Athletics. Thank you.

We are not wasting shots so in the event that we have extra vaccinations for the day, we are calling campus members to see if they can come in on the day-of. We are emailing 1st and 2nd vaccination reservations to all employees when vaccinations are available. We have not forgotten you so please be patient as we wait for more doses.
