- V. New Business
  - A. Lauren Jensen – inquiry about Lavender Graduation 2022
    - i. Can you see yourself (committee members) participating in Lavender Graduation in-person next semester (e.g., part of the procession)?
    - ii. If so, which date would you (committee members) be more likely to attend:
      - 1. **Saturday, May 14<sup>th</sup> mid-day** (weekend before commencement, doesn't conflict with LB Pride)
      - 2. **Monday May 16<sup>th</sup> evening** (historical date/time, may conflict with academic commencement)
      - 3. **Saturday May 21<sup>st</sup> mid-day** (this is not Memorial Day weekend)
    - iii. Which date do you think would work best for students and their loved ones?
      - 1. Committee seems flexible to the celebrations as long as it does not conflict with other graduations, such as Monday evening along with campus/college graduation. Weekends may be hard for those who commute since weekends are not dates where they are typically on campus.
      - 2. Individual celebrations also happen on the weekends, so it may conflict with individual students' schedules; Monday seems to be the least conflicting option.

      - 1. *The affinity group is for faculty and staff, there is a coalition that works through the ASI commissioner that is broader.*
