- D. Status of inquiry about inclusive language in campus policies (Miller & Palkki)
 - i. Working on the specific language
 - ii. Not much experience in writing resolutions so help is needed
 - iii. Two issues with inclusive language:
 - 1. Should all existing policies be required to change to reflect inclusive language?
 - a. If all existing policies, then other issues within those existing policies may become open to other edits. This may cause a huge delay; thereby, losing the main intention of inclusive language.
 - 2. Should only new or policies currently being worked on include inclusive language?
