To be added by a lecturer:

- 3. Current Vita
- 4. Reflective Narrative (as described in 2.1. of the CNSM Evaluation Standards for Lecturers);
- 5. If applicable, a copy of the most recent previous review
- 6. Summary Reports of Student Evaluation of Instructor for each class for which you have student evaluations during the period being evaluated
- 7. Instructional Materials, including course syllabi, and samples of representative assignments and assessment tools.

Optional documents -- only required if part of the job description or if you wish to be evaluated on the following areas:

- 8. Evidence of research activities;
- 9. Evidence of University/Community Service
- 10. Description of advising activities.
