

Data Discussion Guide for Survey Data 2013-14

This discussion guide can be used by program faculty to discuss the results of the Student Success, Exit, and/or Alumni Surveys. The guide can structure conversations about the results of *individual* surveys as well as compare results *across* surveys and develop broader interpretations.

To optimize the discussion, it is helpful to have on hand:

- the summarized survey data (sent by the Assessment Office);
- any statements of program vision, goals, etc.;
- this discussion guide.

Consider the following questions to guide your discussion:

- 1. What are the 2-3 "big things" that jump out at you as particularly <u>positive</u>, that make you proud? Why?
- 2. What are the 2-3 "big things" that strike you as areas for growth and improvement? Why?
- 3. How do the main results of each survey compare?
- 4. How do both the positive areas and those for growth compare to your vision, goals and priorities for the program?
- 5. What steps will you take in the coming year to capitalize on the positives and to make improvements?
- 6. If you will need any resources or supports to facilitate these steps, what might they be?
