ROTATION 1

EDEL 200 (3 units) | 45 hrs. SERVE

- Receive information about the Multiple Subject Credential Program (MSCP)
- Receive SERVE training & start service-learning hours
- After completion of EDEL 200, students are encouraged to attempt the CBEST or complete the *Basic Skills Requirement* in preparation for applying to the Multiple Subject Credential Program

ROTATION 2

ENGL 309 (4 units) | 40 hrs. SERVE

- Advanced composition course analyzing rhetorical structures in the writing of pre-adolescents
- After completion of ENGL 309, students are *encouraged* to start compiling their Multiple Subject Credential Program Application and required documentation

ROTATION 3

40 hrs. SERVE

This rotation is a Liberal Studies graduation requirement for both ITEP and TRACK I students.

ITEP

EDEL 300 (3 units) | 40 hrs. SERVE

- Analysis of curriculum, instruction, & multiple assessment methods
- Upon enrollment for EDEL 300, students should be applying or have applied to the MSCP

TRACK I

INDEPENDENT | 40 hrs. SERVE

- * Option for students who will **not** be pursuing the Multiple Subject Credential
- Students will complete a reflective journal and submit it to SERVE for credit
