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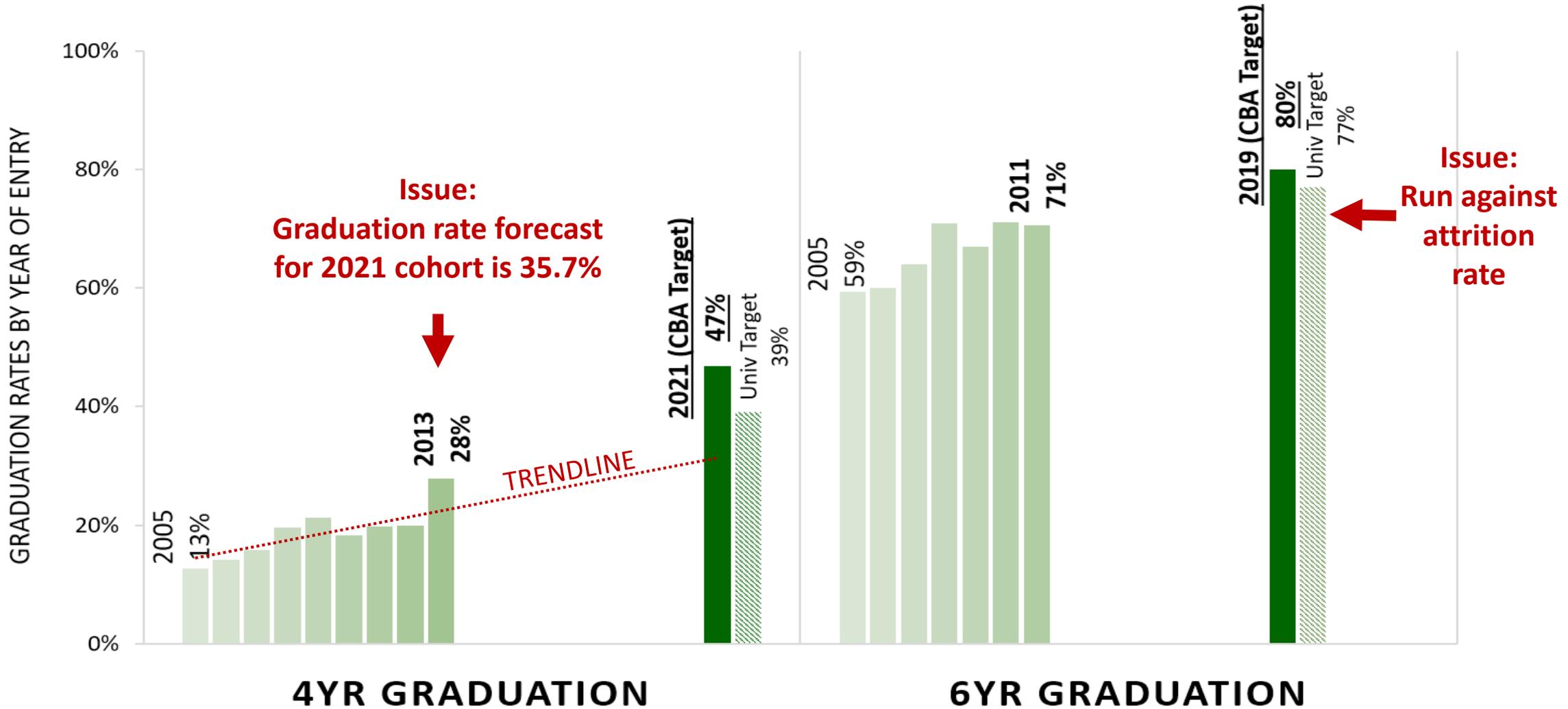

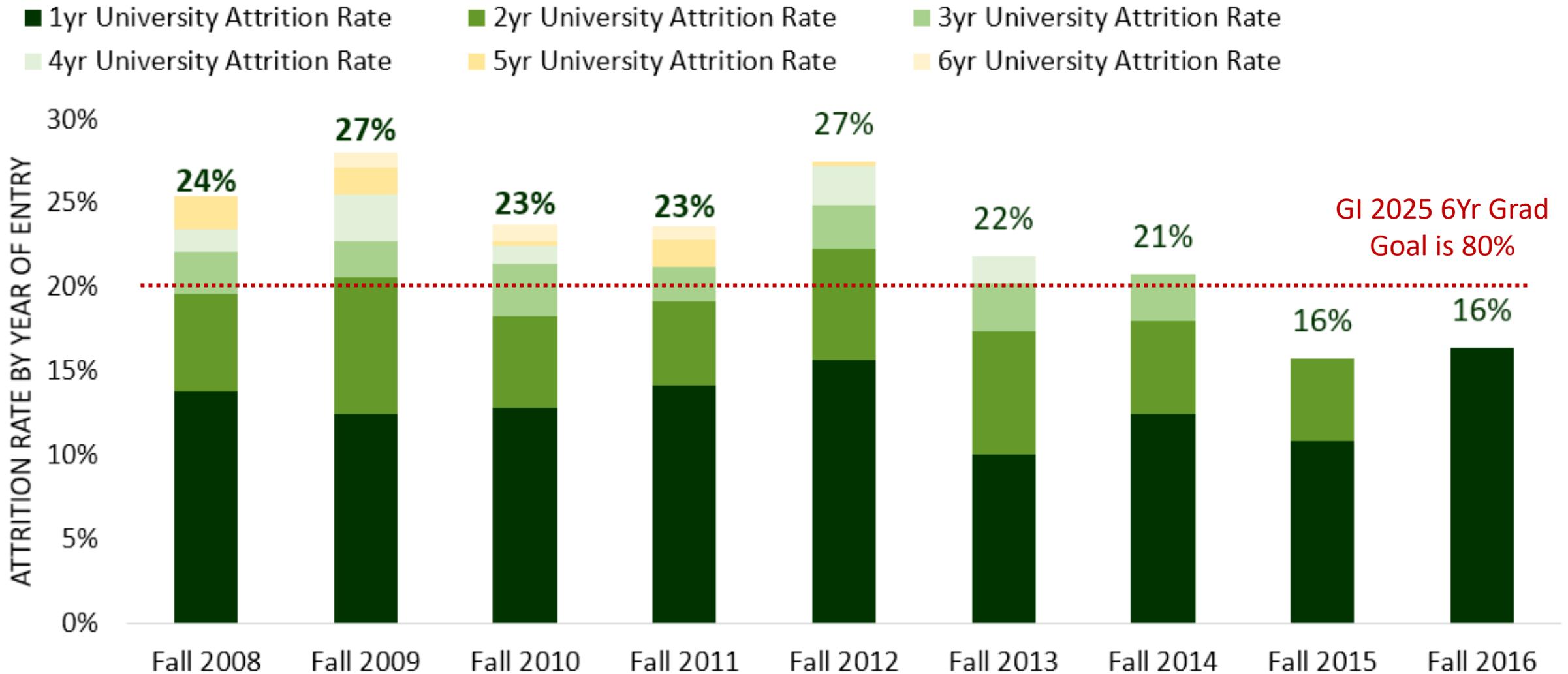
2025 Goals: Increase First-Time Freshmen (FTF) 4 & 6 year grad rates; increase Transfer 2 & 4 year grad rates; and achieve equity by eliminating all equity gaps for underrepresented minorities and Pell eligible students.

Graduation Initiative 2025: First-Time Freshmen

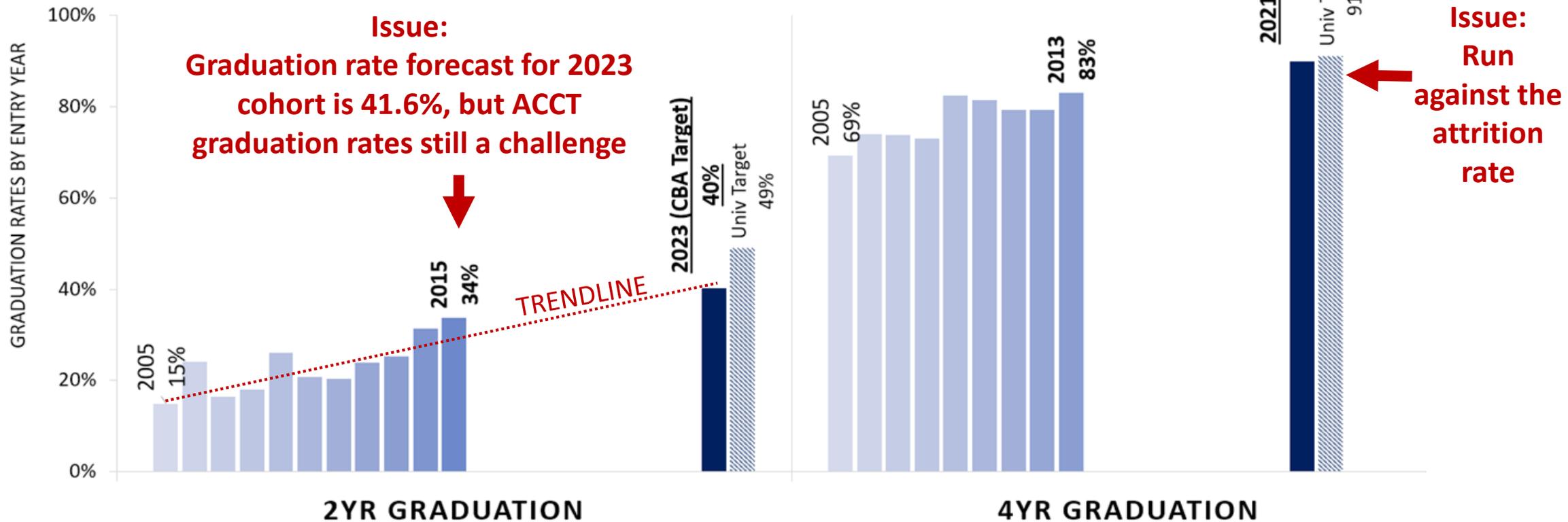


GI 2025: First-Time Freshmen Attrition

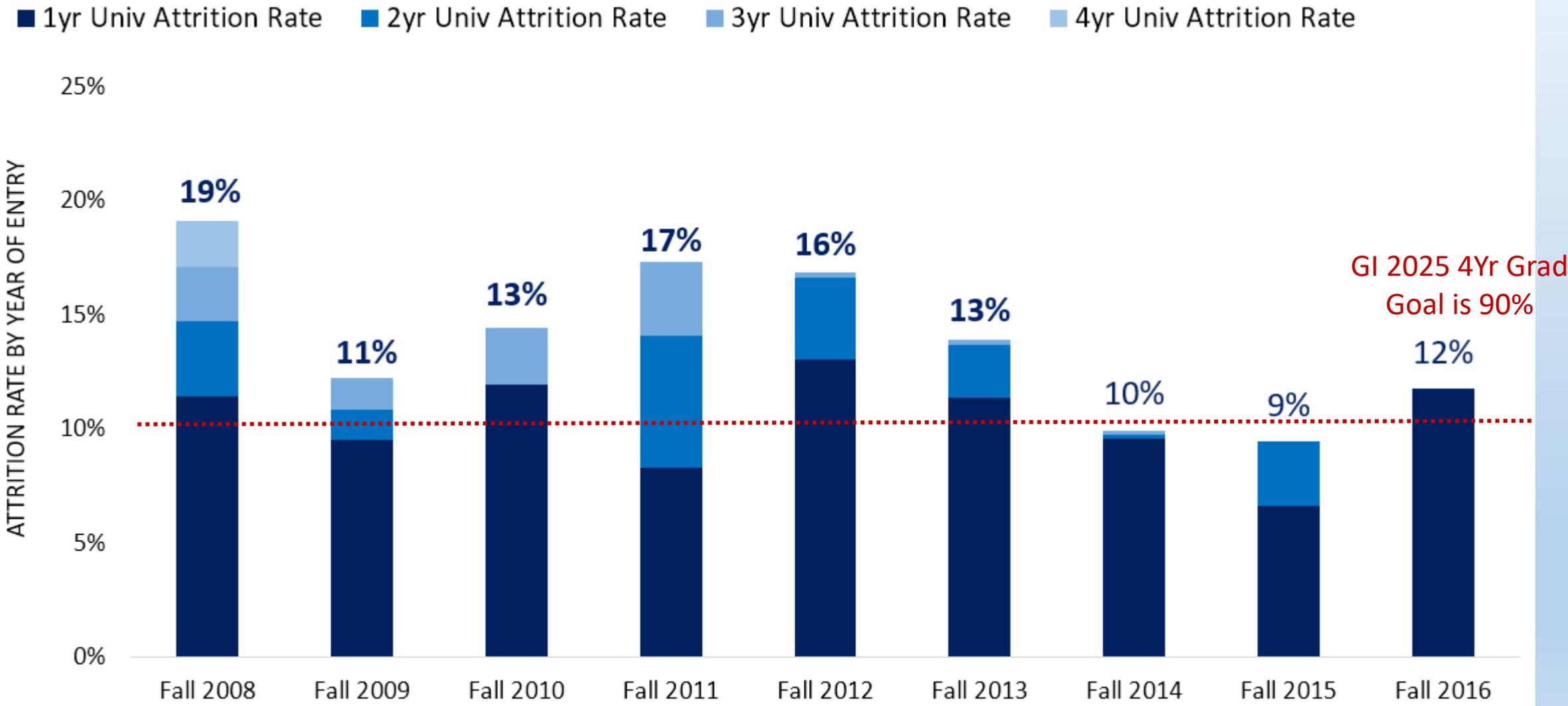


Graduation Initiative 2025: Transfers

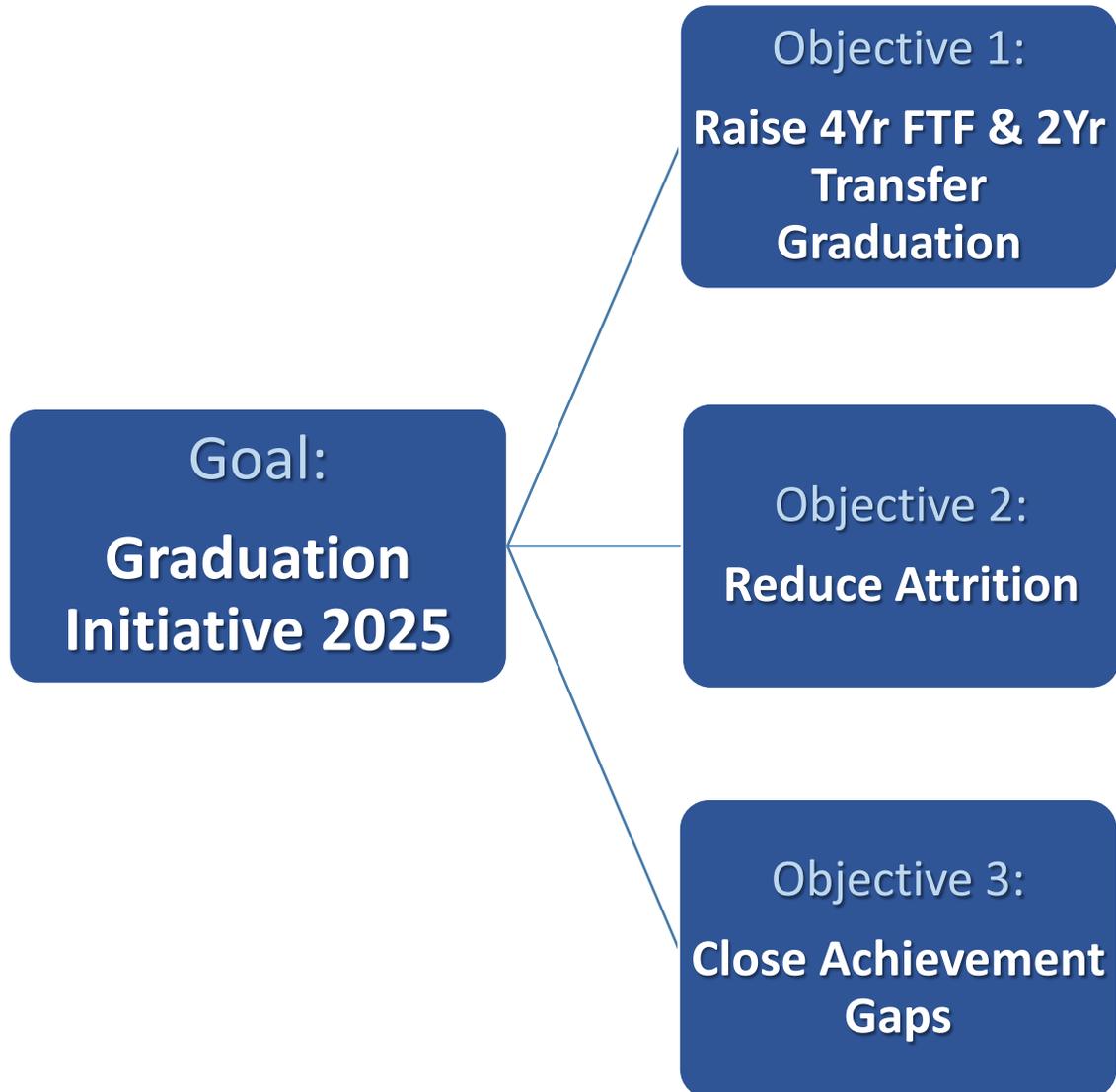
2-YEAR AND 4-YEAR TRANSFER GRADUATION RATES

COLLEGE OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION



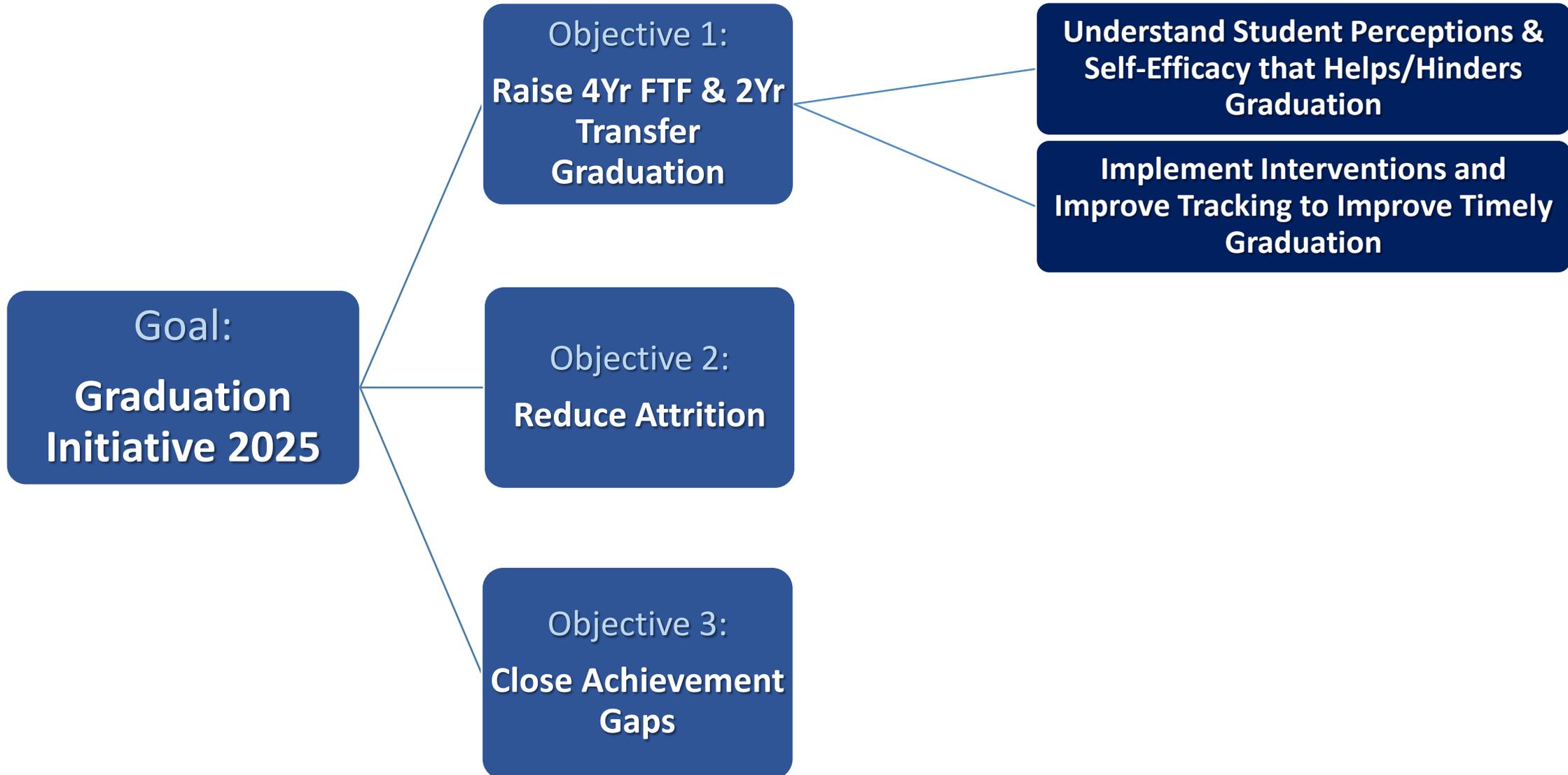
GI 2025: Transfer Attrition

- **Research Questions**

- Upon first joining CSULB...
 - What are goals and plans of our incoming students?
 - How well prepared do they feel in variety of areas?
 - How strong is their self-efficacy?
 - What are their external commitments?

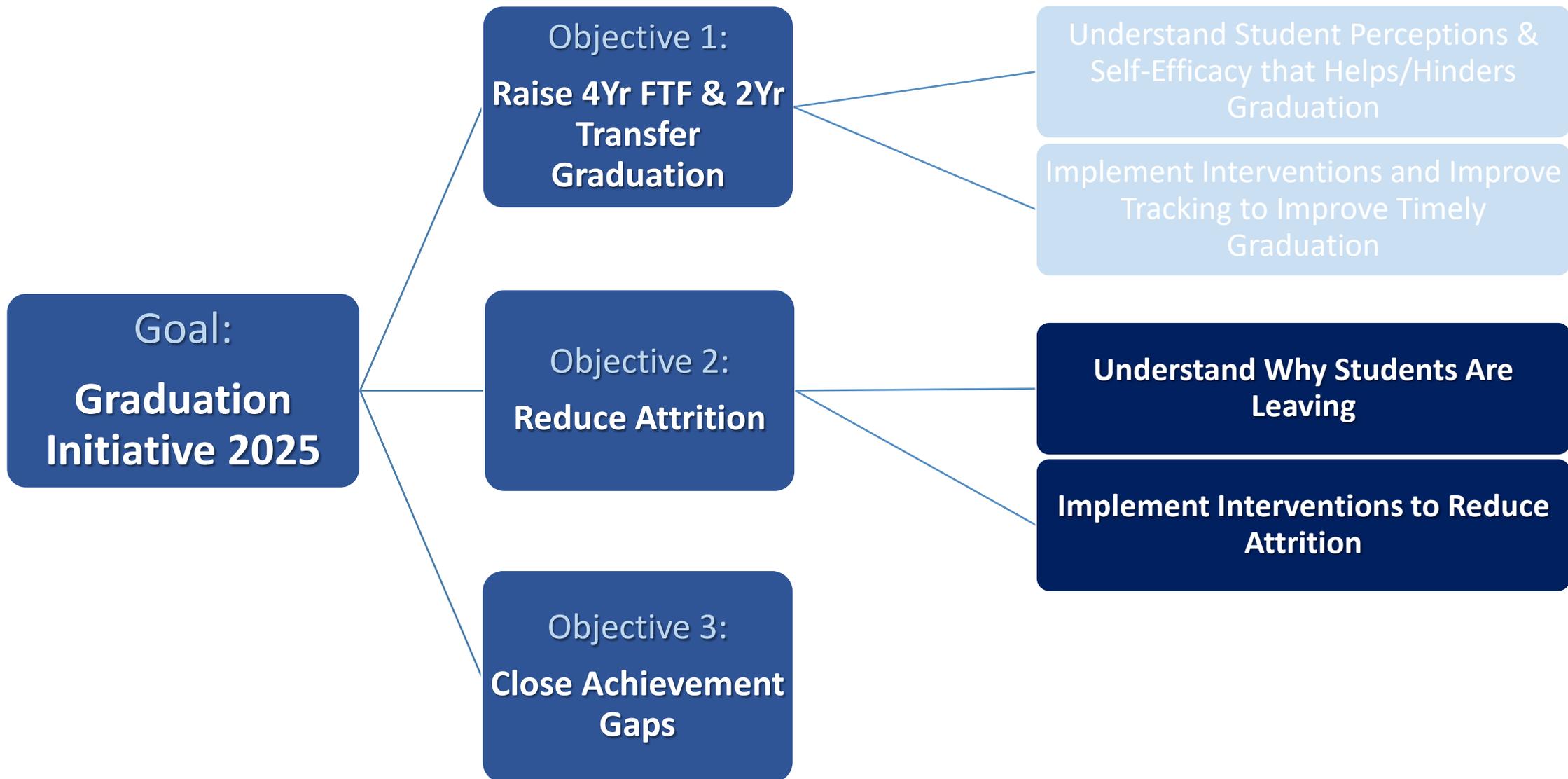
- **Methods**

- Quantitative data from BeachData
- Surveys to collect student perceptions and to identify strong correlations between any variables and 4-year/2-year graduation
 - Spring 2018 Freshmen and Freshmen Beach Pledge Mandatory Workshops Surveys
 - Summer 2018 New Student Survey

Increasing 4Yr FTF and 2Yr Transfer Graduation: Implement Interventions

- Data Fellows research has been used to inform practices in college, including:
 - Introduction of Mandatory Sophomore Advising Workshops
 - Continuation of Early Alert appointments for high D/F/W/WU courses
 - Expanding tutoring options to include GPE prep support, economics, and excel
 - Introduction of Intentional Beach Pledge advising (separate workshops, targeted communication, and schedule checks)
- Next Steps (2018-2019)
 - Using survey, improve our understanding of student perceptions about the 4-year/2-year plan and their self-efficacy so we can determine need for future interventions

- What interventions can the College implement to reduce attrition?

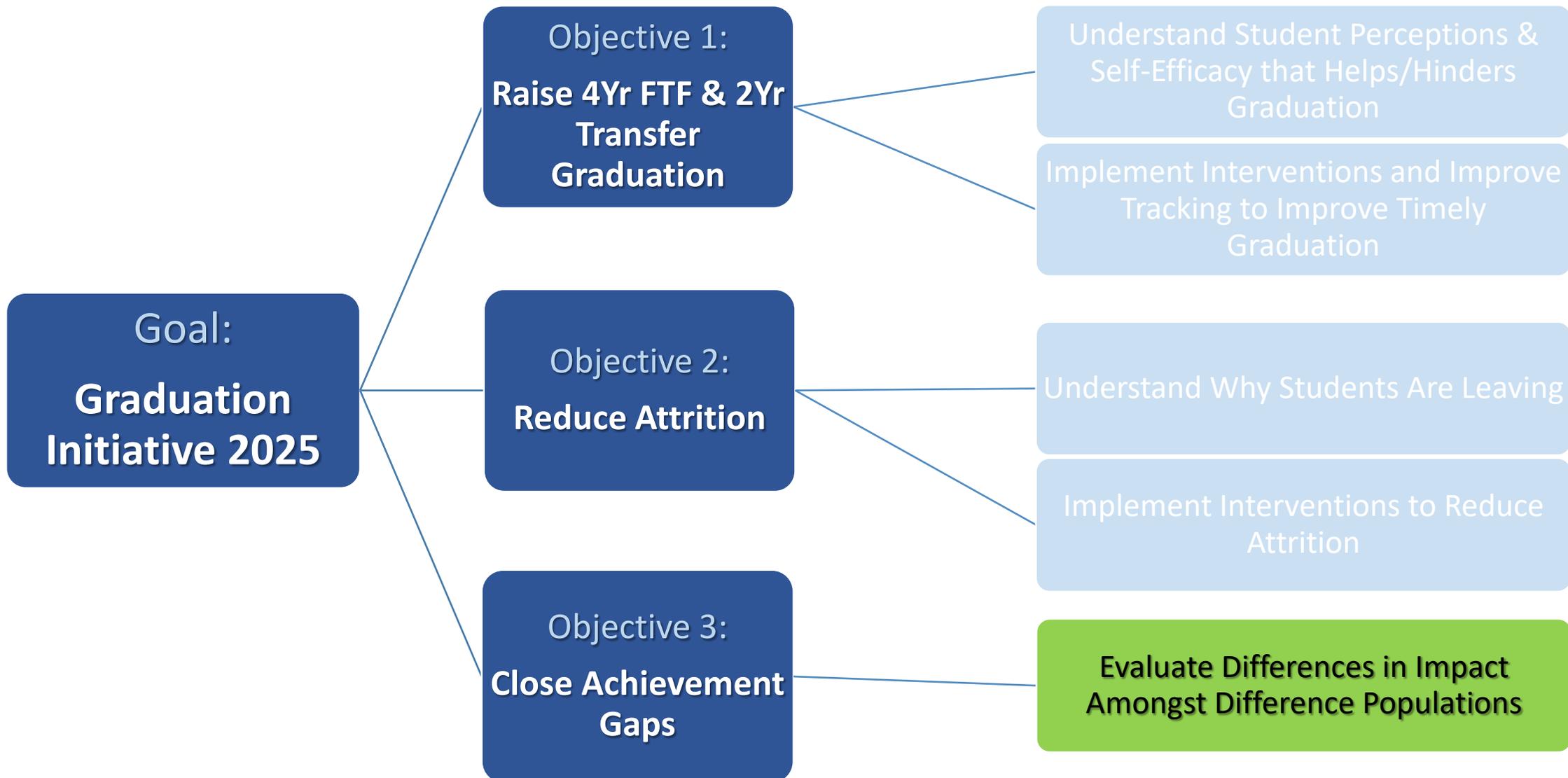
- **Methods**

- Quantitative data from BeachData
- Transcript review
- Surveys to collect student perceptions and to identify any strong correlations between any variables and attrition
 - Spring 2018 Freshmen and Freshmen Beach Pledge Mandatory Workshops Surveys
 - Summer 2018 New Student Survey
 - Fall 2018 Academic Probation Survey

Reducing Attrition: Implement Interventions

- Data Fellows research has been used to inform practices in college, including:
 - Introducing Mandatory Sophomore Advising Workshops
 - Launching Pilot Probation Intervention Workshop
 - Continuing Early Alert appointments for high D/F/W/WU courses
 - Expanding tutoring options to include GPE prep support, economics, and excel
 - First-Time Freshmen Living Learning Communities
- Next Steps (2018-2019)
 - Determine need for future interventions using:
 - Survey to gather student perceptions of self-efficacy and preparedness upon entering CSULB
 - Survey and focus group for students on probation and students that were disqualified
