Every single one of you contributed to the meaningful discussions we embarked upon for developing the GE Policy, the GRs and lastly the GELOs document. Just a few final notes on our work and where we are now:

First of all, congratulations to Nancy Quam-Wickham for a unanimous election as the new Chair for GEGC! Also congratulations to Colleen Dunagan for her unanimous election as the new Vice-Chair. The position of Secretary remains vacant and will need to be filled in the Fall 2020 semester.

I wanted to thank our GEGC Exec for all their hard work especially with the massive workload! A special thank you to my Vice-Chair Cheryl Rock who managed to get the GELOs document finished and approved by the committee in record time and all exec members for the unending prepping and planning and drafting done to make us function like a well-oiled machine. As our final act, the Exec of GEGC approved GEOG 304 with the suggested changes from the committee.

The Academic Senate has one more meeting this semester, where they hope to finalize and vote on the GELOs document. For the most part, the edits approved and suggested thus far have not been substantially different from what we proposed. I think the changes have improved the document and clarified our original purpose in drafting them. The input from campus and academic senate have made it a document that will greatly assist in our evaluation of GE courses and assessment of GE. I will upload the approved version of the GELOs document to Beachboard if it passes.

The GR (Graduation Requirements formerly HD, WI, and GI) document has been tabled until the Fall 2020 semester awaiting further discussion of Ethnic Studies requirements at both the CSU and the state legislature level.

The charge of GEGC has not been changed and the GEEC charge has not yet been adopted. This hasn't been brought to the Academic Senate floor and remains in discussion at the AS executive committee.

It has truly been my pleasure to serve as your chair, I thank you all for the opportunity. May the rest of your academic year be safe and stress-free. I hope to see you all in person this fall (I am practicing the art of optimism).
