The CSULB Graduate Research Conference features distinguished keynote speaker **Tyrone Howard, Ph.D.**, Professor of Education at UCLA. Dr. Howard also serves as the Faculty Director of UCLA Center X and Director of the Black Male Institute.

Dr. Howard's keynote, "Race, Research, Rigor & Relevance: Scholarly Inquiry in the Current Context" will address the ongoing salience of race and racism in the United States, and what it means for scholars engaging in such inquiry. The address will discuss the changing demographics, the continued disenfranchisement of racially diverse populations, and how research can play a role in perpetuating or disrupting current realities.


