


HOW TO SIGN IN ADOBE CREATIVE CLOUD

1. Launch an Adobe Creative Cloud software package. For this guide we will use Adobe Acrobat DC.

Click the Start Menu  and select the Adobe Acrobat DC icon.

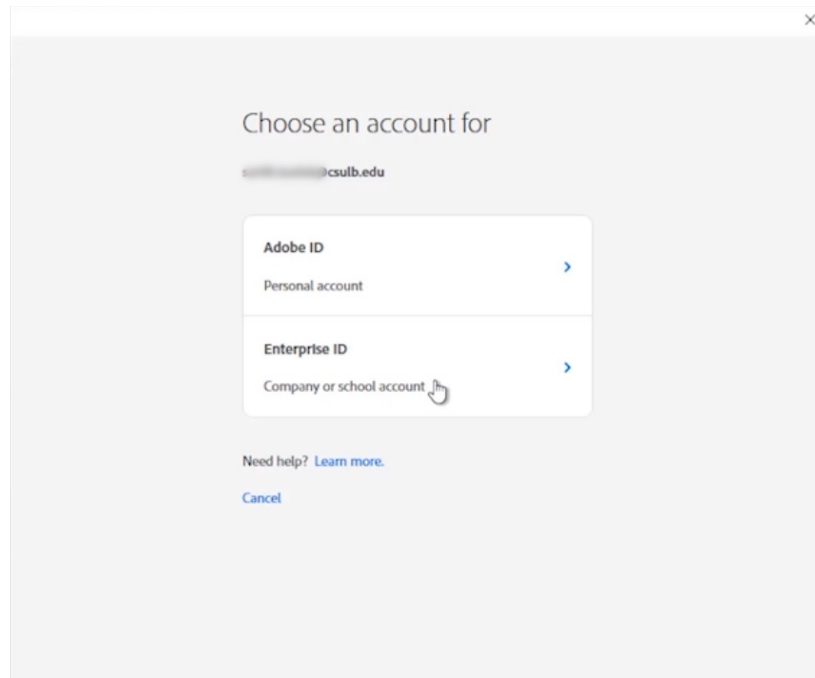


2. Enter your Campus Email Address at the Adobe ID Sign In window (i.e. John.Doe@csulb.edu). Select "Sign On". **NOTE:** Students need to include @student.csulb.edu at the end of their email address.

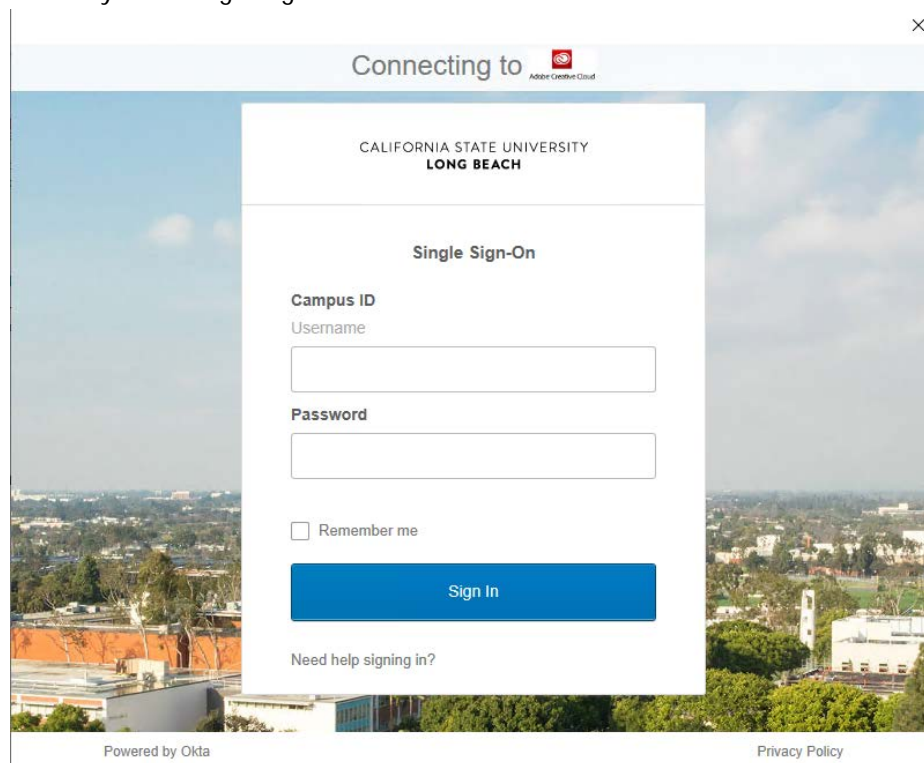
