VISCONTI EXCELLED IN HER ACADEMICS, EARNING A 4.0, DELIVERED HIGH-QUALITY INSTRUCTION AS A TEACHING ASSISTANT, HELPED RUN THE PEXS LAB AS A GRADUATE ASSISTANT, AND CONDUCTED AN IMPRESSIVE MASTERS' THESIS STUDY, A KIND THAT HAD NOT BEEN CONDUCTED IN PEXS LAB PREVIOUSLY. MS. VISCONTI IS AN INCREDIBLY HARD-WORKING AND DRIVEN YOUNG WOMAN WHO ASSUMED A LEADERSHIP POSITION IN THE PEXS LAB AND LED HER OWN RESEARCH TEAM.
