

BA - Concentration Requirement

The Subject Matter Concentration is a requirement for all Liberal Studies BA majors, and requires a minimum of 12 units in one of the thematic programs of study identified below.

Subject Matter Concentrations:

- I. Language Arts
- II. Mathematics
- III. Natural Science
- IV. History-Social Science
- V. Visual and Performing Arts
- VI. Human and Child Development
- VII. Education Studies

Courses taken to satisfy the Subject Matter Concentration requirements shall be selected by the student in consultation with an Academic Advisor.

No Concentration course may be taken Credit/No Credit.

No course used to fulfill a Core requirement may be used to fulfill a Concentration requirement.
