

McNair Scholars Program: Graduate School Application Timeline

June

- Create/Revise CV/Resume
- Create a graduate school list on excel: program names, required materials, deadlines, GRE requirements, recommenders, faculty match
- Prepare a writing sample if needed
- Create/Revise Personal Statement Draft
- Submit a draft to McNair
- Review national fellowship opportunities

July-August

- Study for GRE
- Register for the GRE
- Current major GRE scores (if applicable): _____
- Reach out to potential faculty/grad students at prospective graduate programs
- Revise CV/Resume & Personal Statement Draft

September

- Retake GREs (ONLY if necessary)
- Revise personal statements & CV/Resume (edit with faculty, McNair, GSRC, writing center)
- Create a folder that includes: CV, Personal Statement, List of schools, deadlines
- Ask for letters of recommendation and provide folder for grad school and fellowships
- Begin fellowship applications

October

- Submit FAFSA Oct 1
- Apply to fellowships, scholarships, and grants
- Revise CV/Resume & Personal Statement Draft
- Submit Revised materials to McNair
- Check in with recommenders

November

- Submit fellowship applications
- Finalize graduate applications
- Finalize Personal Statements & CV/Resume or Writing Sample (if applicable)

December

- Double check applications. Keep copies of them after turning them in
- Check status of transcripts, letters of recommendations, GRE scores etc.

January-May

- Wait for admissions offers (fellowships and graduate programs)
- Research cost of living in new cities

- Schedule visits to accepted graduate programs
- Negotiate offers (financial package)
- Confirm offer no later than April 15
- Submit required paperwork by graduate program (transcripts, vaccines, etc.)
