




Studying.

- Headphones




Wellbeing.

- Disinfecting wipes/sprays

Such as, tissues, cough medicine, cough drops, thermometer, chapstick, Tylenol or Ibuprofen, Vitamin C or supplements.
- Extra trash bags
- Entertainment
E.g., books, gaming, magazines, etc.



Living.

- Wallet/purse and money
- Clothing for ≥14 days
- Comfortable shoes
- Passport or state ID
- Snacks and comfort food
- CSULB ID and keys
- Water and other beverages
- Optional bedding and pillow
If you don't want to use provided linens.



Cleaning.

- Body wash or body soap
- Shampoo and conditioner
- Towels for showering
- Hand soap
- Toothbrush and toothpaste
- Skin care products
- Contact lens and solution
- Glasses
- Razors and shaving cream
- Deodorant
- Feminine hygiene products
- Hair supplies and hair dryer



What's provided.

Your on-campus isolation location will be stocked with the following:

- Trash bags
- Toilet paper
- Mini fridge
- Microwave
- Linens (sheets, blanket, pillow)

You will not be allowed back into your on-campus space until you are cleared to return. No personal items will be retrieved for you after you have moved into your isolation space. Therefore, please double check all of your daily personal, professional, and academic needs are met with the items you take into isolation. Dining will be available for food delivery during your isolation, and look for more information on how to place your orders in the communication you will be emailed.

If you have a service animal or ESA that requires being let out, you must find someone off-campus to take your animals for all 14 days of isolation or you must find an off-campus location to isolate. You will not be permitted to leave your room to walk your animal or have guests come in and out of the building to walk it for you. Staff will not walk your animal.

Please be careful not to bring too many belongings, as the following two scenarios are possible:

- 1) In the event of an order to decrease residence hall population, you may be required to remove all your belongings from campus within a short time frame.
- 2) In the event of an ease in COVID-19 restrictions, you may be paired with a roommate for spring semester.
