

Supplemental Instruction Leader

JOB DESCRIPTION

As a component of The Learning Center, Supplemental Instruction (SI) supports students enrolled in historically difficult classes. SI provides support in the form of a one-unit, CR/NC course (S/I 60). Each SI section is attached to a specific course (target course). SI Leaders, students who have already succeed in the course, attend lectures with the students and lead 2 – 3 weekly study sessions in which they facilitate a variety of hands-on learning activities to foster a deeper understanding of the course material.

SI are collaborative experiences to (1) help students master course content and (2) encourage reflection on their evolution as a life-long learner.

Duties include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Hold SI sessions according to course schedule
- Attend pre-semester orientation and weekly insemester training
- Attend each target course lecture and model ideal student behavior
- Prepare lesson plans for each SI session
- Meet regularly with faculty teaching the target course
- Hold office hours for student visits
- Maintain records of student attendance and performance
- Periodically meet with SI Coordinators
- Respect the privacy of student information, grades, and performance
- Conduct peer observations of other SI leaders sessions
- Maintain a professional working environment in the classroom, on-campus, and online environment
- Other duties as assigned.
