SB 2042 PRELIMINARY MULTIPLE SUBJECT TEACHING CREDENTIAL

- Valid for 5 years from issue date
- Eligible to teach in a self-contained classroom grades Preschool, K-12, and adults
- English Learner Authorization
 - Your credential will include an English Learner Authorization
 - Code ELAM - Multiple Subject

PRELIMINARY EDUCATION SPECIALIST TEACHING CREDENTIAL

- Valid for 5 years from issue date
 - Grade levels Kindergarten, 1-12 through age 22
 - Includes English Learner Authorization – code ELAE
 - Mild/Moderate Authorization includes additional Autism Authorization OR Moderate/Severe

PRELIMINARY CREDENTIAL EVALUATIONS

- Student Teaching is noted as “in progress” (IP) until grades have posted
- Missing items are noted as “Needs” and must be submitted prior to credential recommendation
 - CPR – Adult, Infant, & Child (online course is acceptable)
 - RICA – email 1st page of pdf showing passage of all 3 subtests
 - ITEP – must wait for your BA to post on your myCSULB record
 - CalTPA
 - Scores will be sent directly to CSU Long Beach and clearance will be provided by your program after you complete your CTC program survey
- Multiple Subject note - Added Authorization Information – If an analyst has included a note that you qualify for an “Added Authorization” you must notify us if you want the authorization. You want to make sure it is a subject you would be willing to teach.

APPLYING FOR YOUR CREDENTIALS

SPRING 2022

- ❑ Step 1: Complete the Multiple Subject Program Survey and submit receipt to TPAC. After you have completed the survey and passed the TPA the TPAC office will send us a program clearance signed off by Dr. Isbell.
- ❑ Step 2: : After all requirements on your credential evaluation have been completed (including the degree for ITEP students):
 - ❑ Complete the Request for Recommendation Qualtrics form and submit any missing documentation, ex: RICA, CPR, etc.
 - ❑ IMPORTANT - You will need to provide a non CSULB email on this form. Please ensure that you will be giving us the same email address that you have on file with the CTC
- ❑ Step 3: A CSULB Credential Analyst will do a final evaluation and submit an online recommendation on your behalf to the Commission on Teacher Credentialing.
- ❑ Step 4: You will receive an email from the CTC asking you to complete the next portion of the online application.

As of today, the CTC has a credential fee waiver in place for your 1st credential. The fee waiver will only be available until June 30th (or until funds run out, whichever is first).

- ❑ Step 5: Within approximately 10 days of completing the CTC application, you will receive notification from the Commission that your documents have been granted and are available for viewing in your Educator Profile.
- ❑ Step 6: Print and carefully review your credential documentation. Contact the Credential Center ASAP if your document is not correct, or if you have questions

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- All candidates must complete the CTC/CSULB Exit Survey. A delay in submitting this document to the TPAC office can cause delays in your credential process.
- Be sure to keep a personal portfolio of all test scores, evaluations, etc.
- All candidates will receive an: Individual Development Plan (IDP) at the completion of your program.
 - This document will provide recommendations for professional development and growth during your clear induction program.
 - Share this document with your Teacher Induction Program

CLEAR CREDENTIAL

- To earn a Clear Credential, completion of an induction program is required
 - Induction programs are offered by:
 - Districts
 - County Offices of Education
 - Universities
 - When completed, you apply for the Clear Credential through the induction program sponsor
 - You are earning 2 credentials, but you only need to do 1 induction program
- Clear Credentials are renewed online every five years

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- What happens if I do not finish and apply for my Preliminary Credential(s)?
 - Your Credential Center file will be put on "hold" until you complete all requirements and return to our office to apply for your credential.
 - Be aware that some requirements expire – ex: fingerprints, CSET examinations, CPR, coursework, and program standards.
- What happens if my Preliminary 5-year Credential expires?
 - You do not need to complete a new Preliminary Credential Program
 - Extensions may be available, but MAY be subject to new regulations
- I am moving out of state, can I complete induction out of state?
 - Officially the answer is "no", but if you earn another credential out of state and teach on that new document, you may be able to use this to help you earn your CA Clear Credential. Please contact our office for more information.

SUPPLEMENTARY & SUBJECT MATTER AUTHORIZATIONS

- Added directly to your Multiple Subject Credential document
- Authorizes departmentalized teaching in grades 9 and below (middle school)
- Earned strictly through coursework
- Supplementary = 20 semester units and meet core areas
- Subject Matter = 32 semester units and meet core areas
 - Example of subjects available: Introductory English; Introductory Science; Introductory Math
 - Full list available on the CTC website
- Email ced-credentials@csulb.edu for advising if you feel you have the appropriate units in the subject you are interested in.
- There is no additional fee if applying with initial credential
- After you have earned your credential, there will be a \$25 evaluation service fee

SINGLE SUBJECT CREDENTIAL OPTION EDUCATION CODE - 80499

- Single Subject Credential - Authorization to teach in a departmentalized classroom in grades preschool, K-12, and adults
 - Must hold a valid Multiple Subject Credential
- Earned by completing the following requirements:
 - Subject Matter Competency – Can be met via one of these options:
 - CSET in appropriate subject
 - CTC Approved Waiver Program
 - BA or Higher Degree
 - Combination Coursework and CSET
 - Subject specific methods course –
 - EDSS 450 (at CSULB)
