Golshani previously served as an Advisor to the Costa Rica Minister of Science and the President of Technologica de Costa Rica. He has worked as a senior manager or technical consultant for Boeing, Bull Worldwide Systems, Honeywell, Intel, McDonnell Douglas Helicopter, Motorola, and Sperry. He is a Fellow of IEEE and the National Academy of Inventors.

Before coming to CSULB, Golshani served as NCR Distinguished Professor and Chairman of the Computer Science and Engineering Department at Wright University in Ohio. He was also Center Director and Professor at Arizona State University, and Research Fellow at Imperial College in London. He holds a B.S. from Arya Mehr University of Technology in Tehran, Iran, and an M.S. and PhD from University of Warwick, England.
