Demonstrated potential for effective teaching. Must have the ability to communicate effectively with an ethnically and culturally diverse campus community.

Desired/Preferred Qualifications

Ph.D. in Mathematics, Statistics, or Math Education. Demonstrated expertise in field of course(s) to be taught, evidence of successful teaching in college-level math, statistics, or math ed courses.

Duties

Teach up to 15 units of courses such as GE Math, College-level Algebra, Trigonometry, Calculus for Business, Calculus, Mathematical Ideas, Mathematics for Elementary Teachers, Elementary Statistics, associated support courses, and upper-division and graduate courses according to department needs. Required mode of instruction may include in-person, hybrid, online, and/or any combination thereof.
