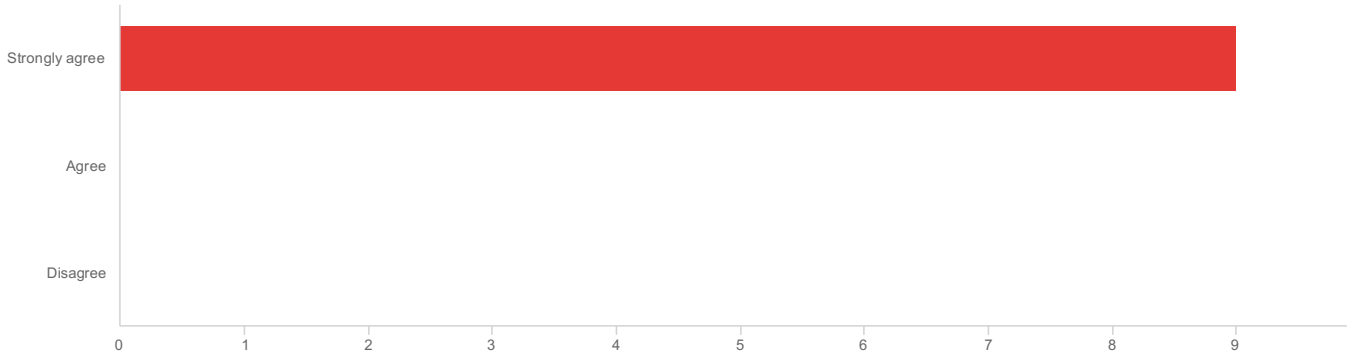


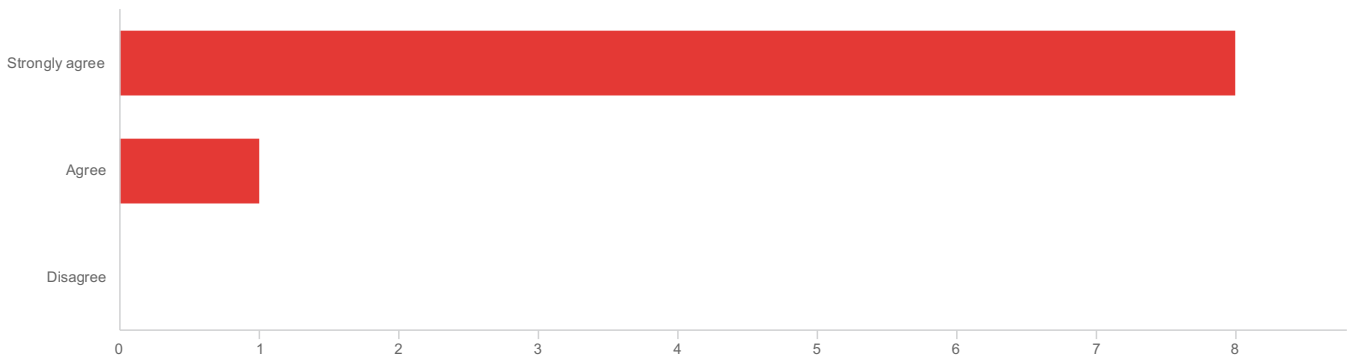

Did the schedule allow you time to process what you were reading and discussing from the meetings?



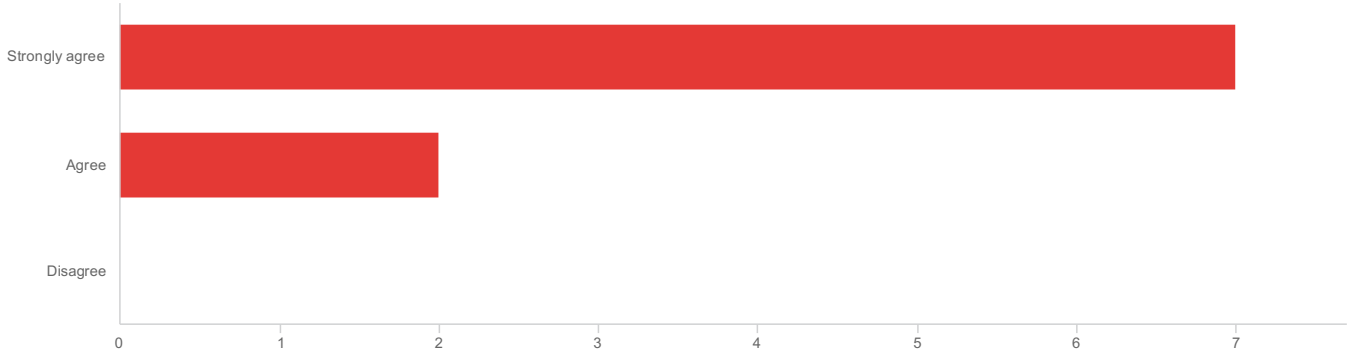

Did the schedule allow you to feel a sense of community with your WAC Fellows?



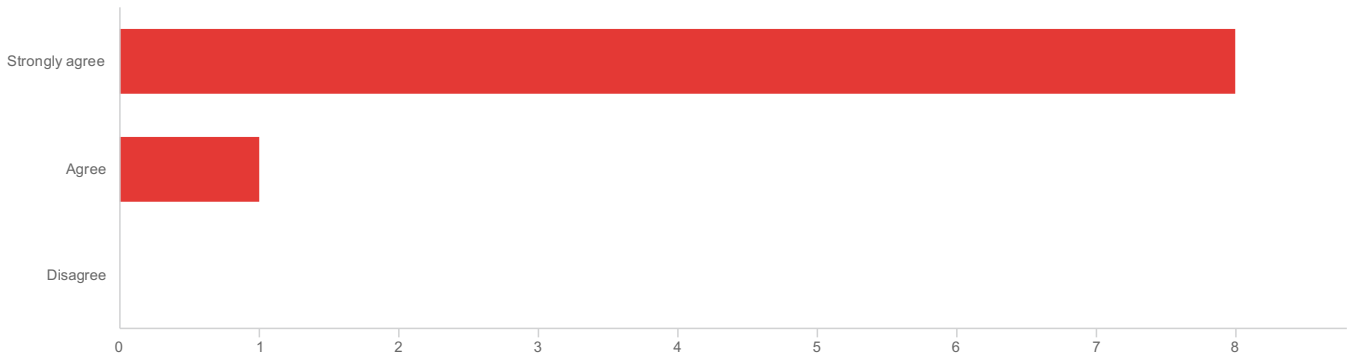

Was the text (John Bean's Engaging Ideas) for the WAC Fellows useful?



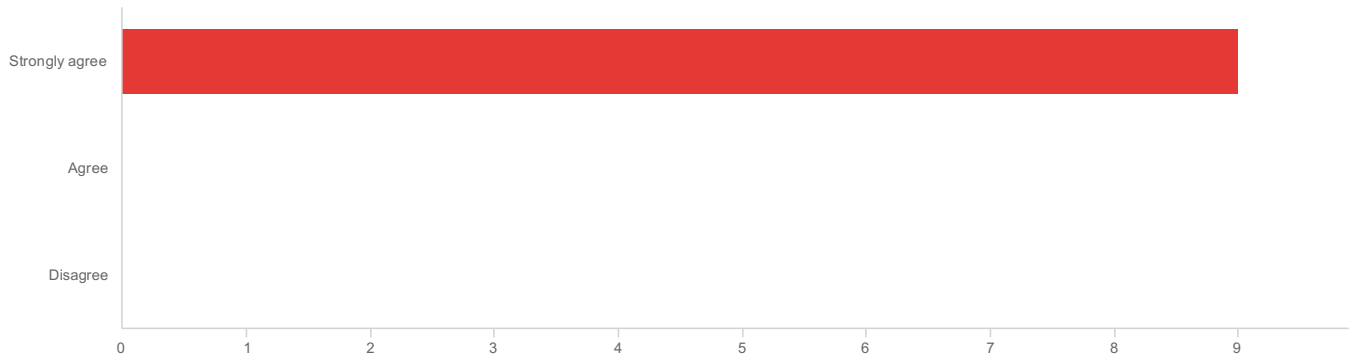

Did you find the tasks you had to do for the WAC Fellows useful?



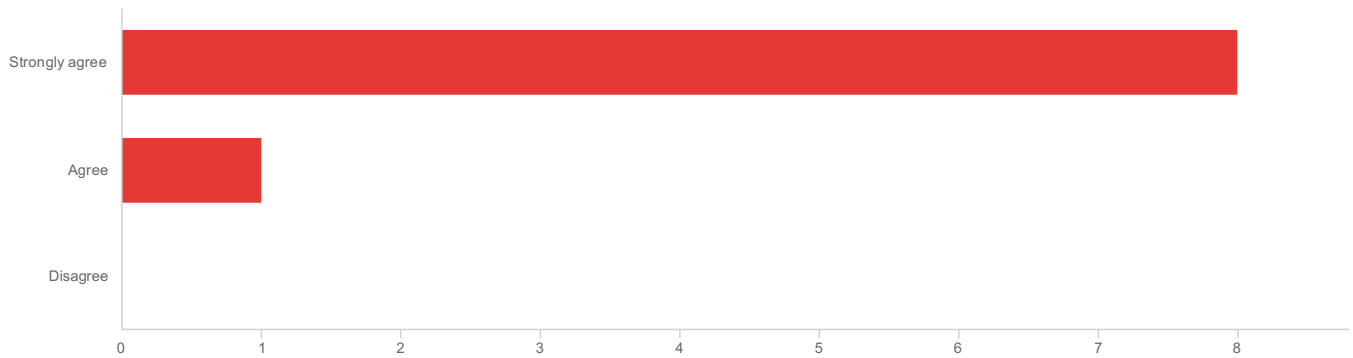

Were the group conversations from the readings helpful in advancing your teaching writing strategies?



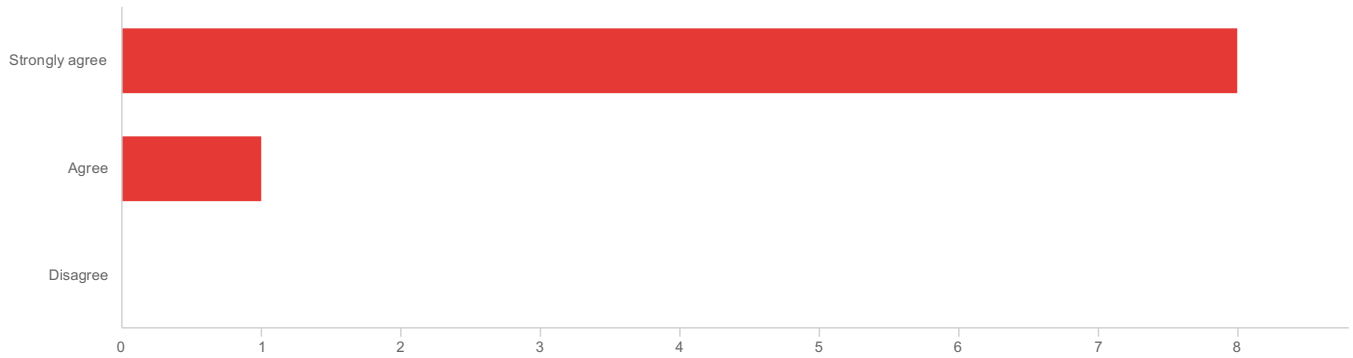

Were the discussions of peer WAC Fellows' projects useful in advancing your teaching writing strategies?



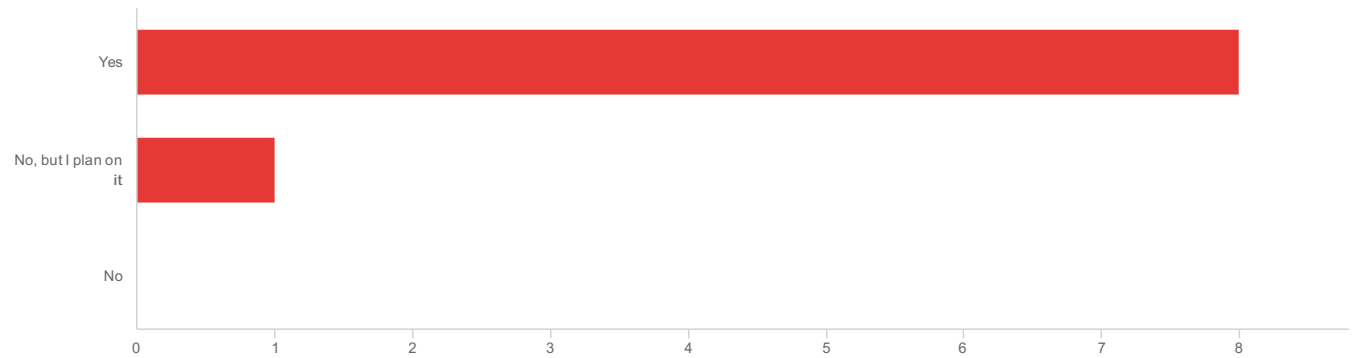

Were you comfortable discussing your projects with the WAC Fellows?



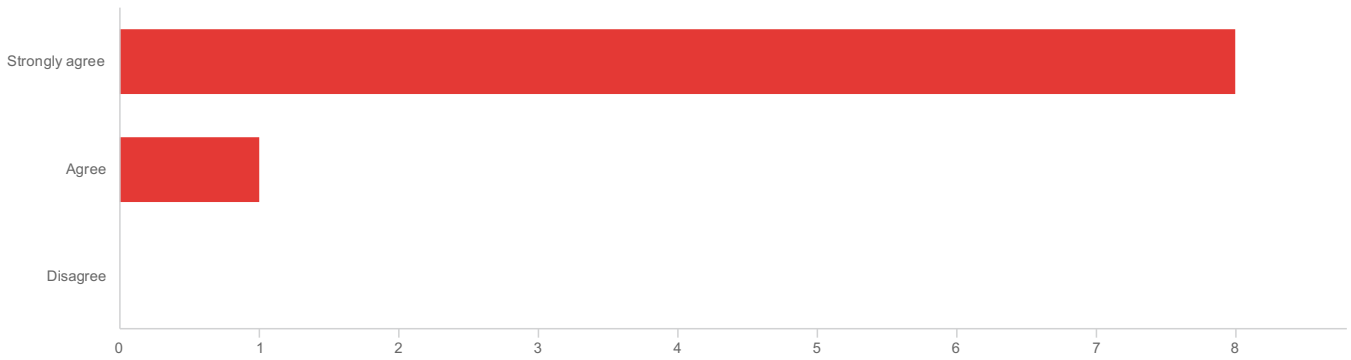

Have you discussed any of your new teaching strategies with your colleagues?



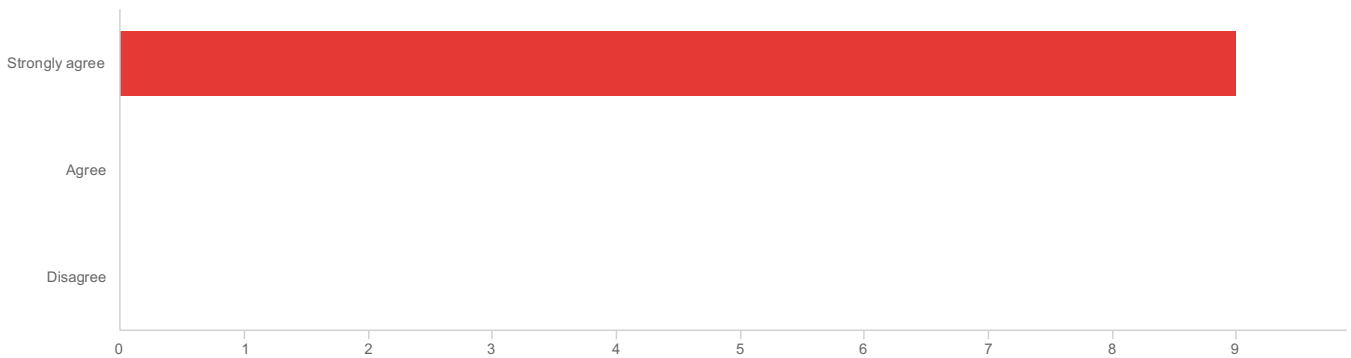

Was the meeting schedule (days/times) convenient for you?



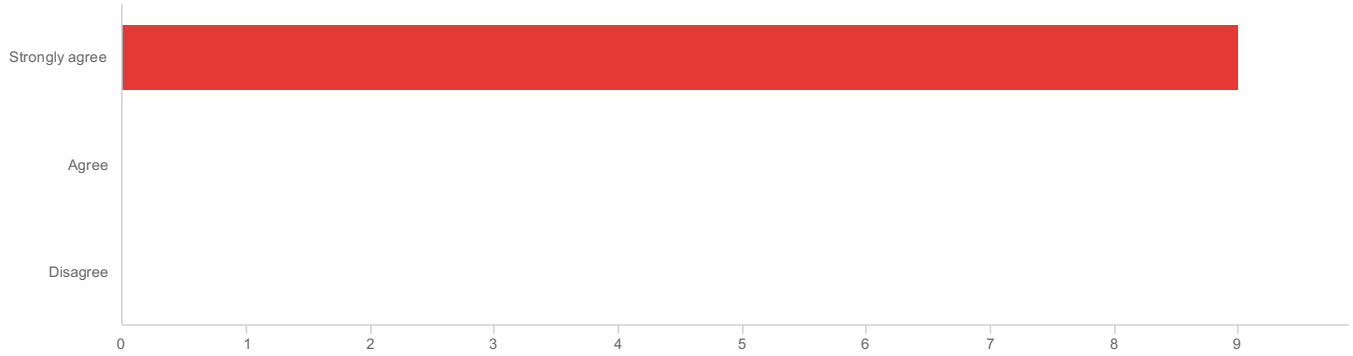

Would you recommend the WAC Fellows to colleagues?



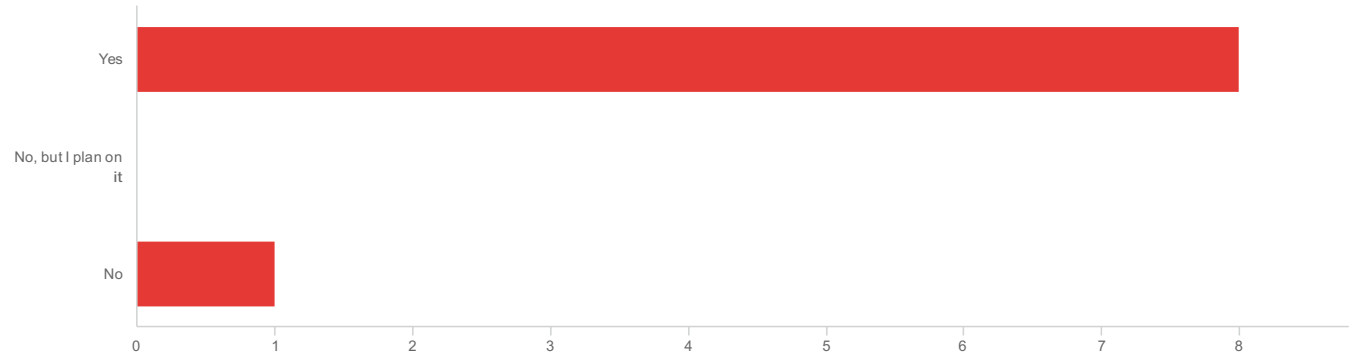

From the WAC meetings, discussions, and workshops, were you able to learn new ideas n teaching writing?



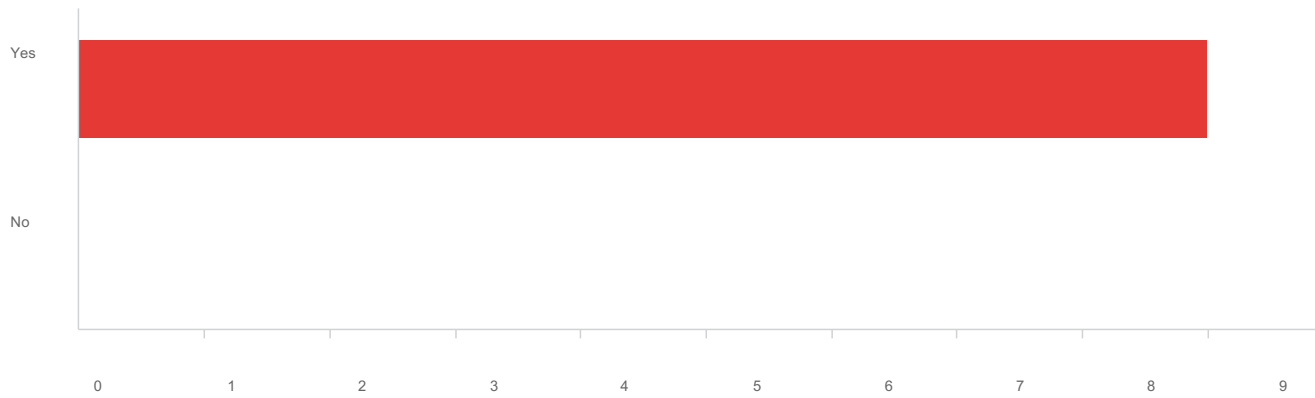

Were you able to introduce more writing into your classes this academic year?



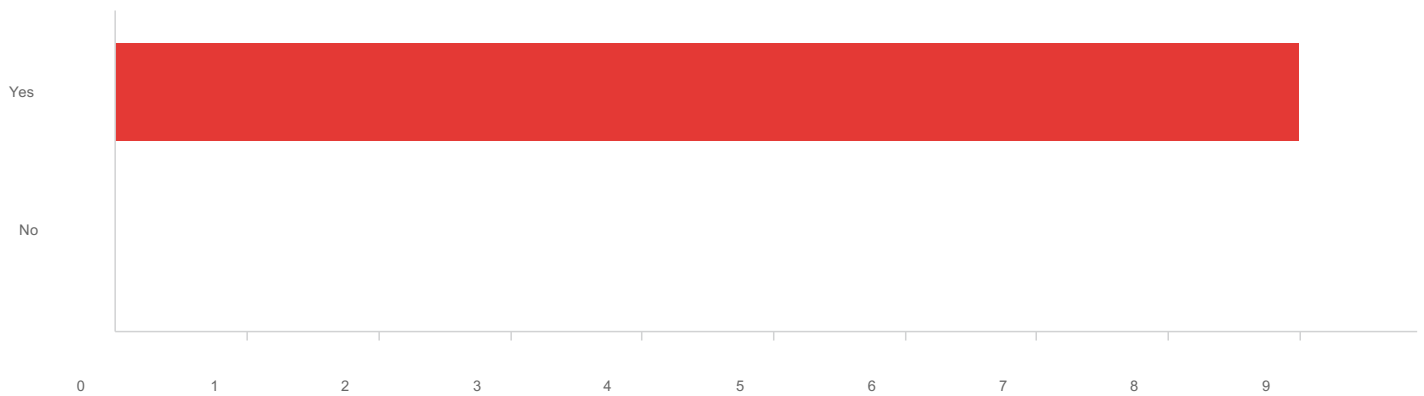

Do you feel the stipend was appropriate for your investment in the WAC Fellows?



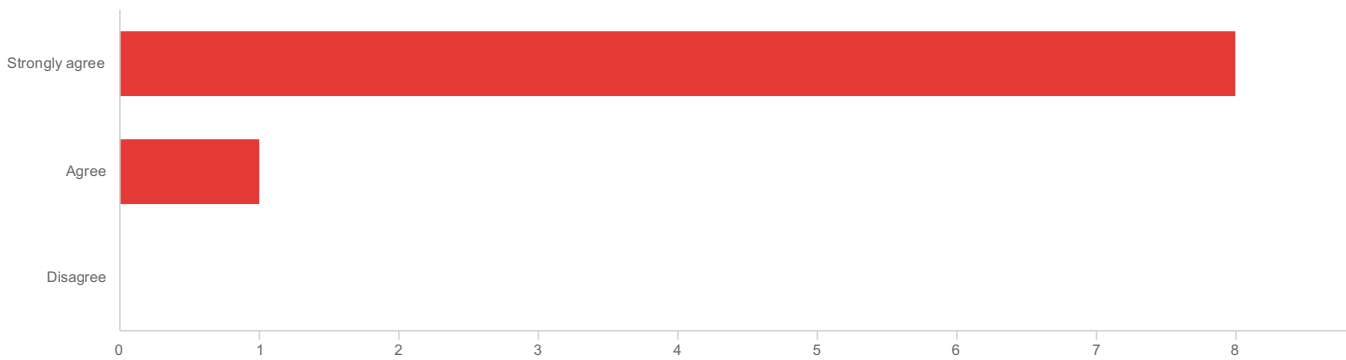

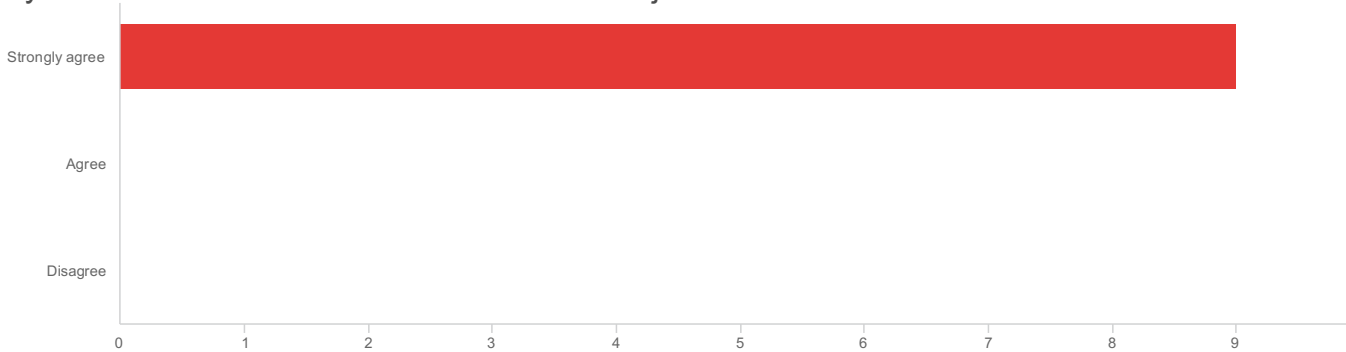

Was your WAC mentor enthusiastic about the subject matter?



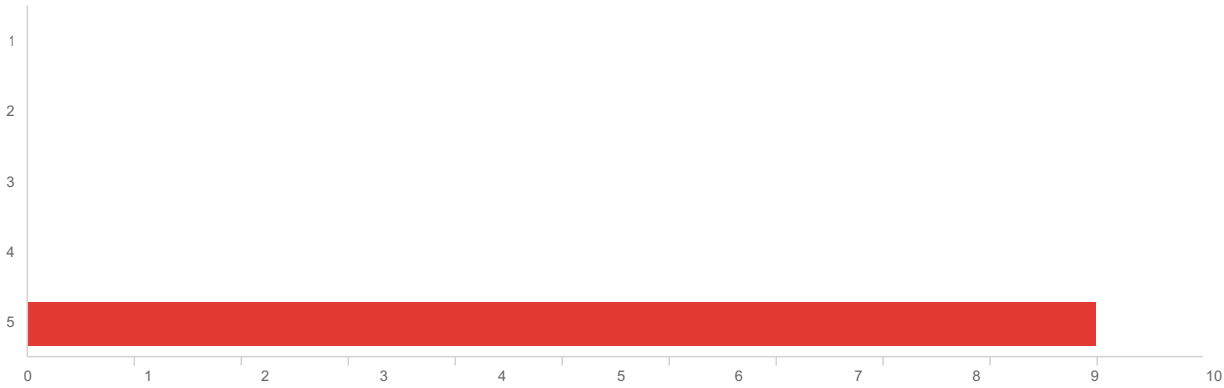
