

Reinstatement Petition to Academic Appeals Committee

Disqualified students may apply for reinstatement once they have been out of attendance for at least one fall or spring semester. To be considered for reinstatement to the University, a disqualified student must:

- Demonstrate progress toward a degree by satisfying the [Major Specific Declaration Requirements](#)
- Show efforts to raise the grade point average (GPA) by reducing the grade point deficiency by at least one-half
- Demonstrate an ability to complete the chosen major within established University policies, including Repetition of Courses, Academic Progress Rules and [Timely Graduation](#)
