




PHOTO GUIDELINES

Photo types are limited to .jpg, .png. Maximum file size is 5MB.

All student submissions will be reviewed and any content that is considered obscene, threatening, abusive, or illegal will result in their slide being removed from the program. We may also remove slides containing unrelated business solicitations or other commercial advertising.

Below is a list of content will result in the removal of your slide in commencement events:

- Obscene, lewd, explicit, discriminatory, derogatory, violent, offensive, infringing, or otherwise inappropriate content
- Commercial advertisements including sponsor names, logos, slogans, websites and phone numbers
- Social media handles and hashtags
- Offensive or negative references to any other college
- Names, images or likeness of any other student or person
- Obscene or offensive language
- Photos cannot be used to promote other college
- Statements or endorsements of political candidates
- Third party logos/branding

If you do not hit submit, your recording may not be saved.

INITIAL EVENT WAIVERS AND SUBMIT

To complete your slide, you will need to initial the photography waiver and the event general liability waiver. To submit or save your slide updates, click 'submit' at the bottom of the page. You will be able to log back in and make changes up until the final deadline date.





HOW TO OPT OUT OF HAVING A GRAD SLIDE

All graduates will have a grad slide created for them listing their name, degree, major, college, and graduation term.

The grad slides will be available on the commencement website beginning May 16, 2022, with public access to view, download, and share. If a graduate would prefer to opt-out of having a grad slide created, then they can contact the commencement office to have the information removed.
