- **Location:** Scattered.
- **Language Status:** 5 (Developing).
- **Dialects:** Regional variations: deaf people along the North coast have some distinct signs from deaf people in the southern part of the country.
- **Language Development:** At least 12 institutions offer primary education for deaf Hondurans with Honduran Sign Language as their communication philosophy.”
