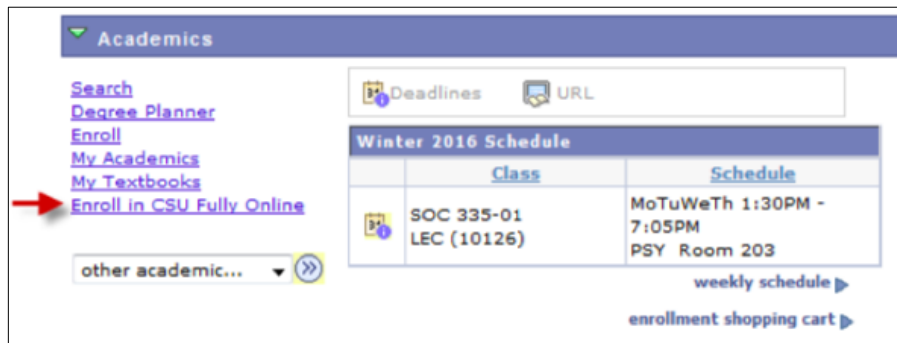


How to Enroll in CSU Fully Online

Before enrolling in an online course at another CSU, you should complete the CSU Fully Online Readiness Survey (available on the [CSU Fully Online](#) website) to be sure that this program is right for you. Consult with your academic advisor to determine if the course can apply to your degree requirements.

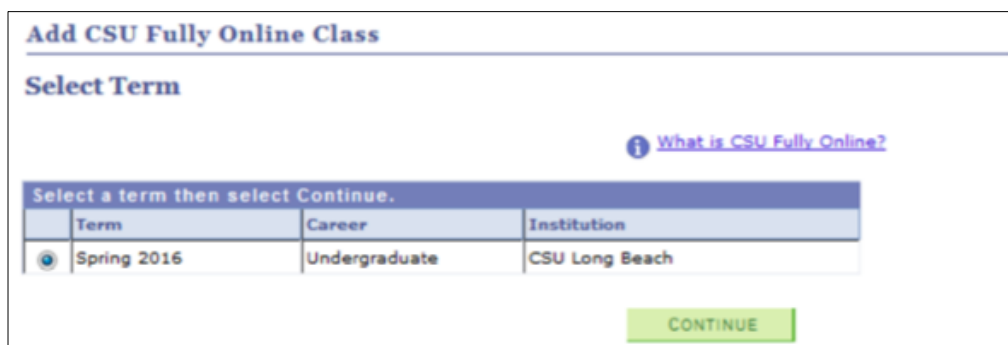
Once you have reviewed the CSU Fully Online requirements and determined you are eligible to participate in the program:

1. Select the **Enroll in CSU Fully Online** link in your Student Center.



2. Select term of enrollment and select **Continue**.

3. Search for available CSU Fully Online classes.

Description

In this course, personal, family, school, and community health are the framework for presenting coordinated health education in K-12 schools to teaching credential candidates. Subject matter includes school health laws, universal precautions, common diseases and prevention, drugs, alcohol and tobacco, sexuality, nutrition, fitness, pregnancy, special populations, child abuse, bullying, gender issues, community, diversity, and human ecology. Based upon California Health Framework, meets state credential requirements. Prerequisite: admission to the Education Specialist Credential Program or permission of the instructor.
